



## The Wayfarers' July Walk at Sixhills

**DATE:** SATURDAY, 15 July, 2017

**MEETING POINT:** "Park & Ride", (layby West of Humber Bridge South roundabout) Ferriby Road, Barton at 10-00 am.

**START** **11 am** from Sixhills. Sixhills is about 1 mile off High Street (B1225), first turning on right after High Street crosses the A631 (Market Rasen to Louth road). You can go via Market Rasen or Caistor or Caenby corner. As you enter the village from High Street, turn left at the T-junction. Parking is on the right near a big barn a few yards from the junction. It can also be reached via North Willingham, which is slightly shorter (no turn in Sixhills).

**DISTANCE & TERRAIN:** About 5.5 miles. The walk is over field paths and minor roads. There are two hills, and a stick would be useful.

**TAKE:** Wet weather clothing, boots essential (one muddy patch), packed lunch.

**COST:** £1 per person, children free.
